

## Admissions and Settling In

It is our intention to make our Nursery accessible to children and families from all sections in the community. In order to accomplish this we,

- Advertise in all areas.
- Arrange a waiting list.
- Describe the Nursery and its practice in terms, which make it clear that anyone is welcome.
- Monitor the gender and culture of children to ensure that no accidental discrimination is made.
- Make our equal opportunities widely known.

Walmer Bridge Day Nursery endeavours to ensure a smooth transition for both parents and children from home to nursery.

Each child and parent will be invited to the nursery before his or her start date, for a series of taster days. It is requested that their parent/carer or legal guardian accompany the child for at least three visits of approximately one hour each.

Each child will be allocated a key person who will co-ordinate and conduct these sessions to enable parents and children to build up a positive relationship before that start date.

The taster days are completely flexible and can be increased dependant on the needs of the child.
